

ENERGY MANAGEMENT POLICY

We place great importance on energy management for environmental sustainability. We set goals and implement various measures to ensure energy savings and to use resources efficiently and effectively. We continuously review our energy management processes, keep track of technological innovations, and adopt best practices.

We prioritize collaboration with all our stakeholders to create common goals and outcomes in energy management. We strive to maintain our interactions with our guests, employees, visitors, and all our business partners to achieve a collective level of awareness and consciousness on these matters.

We organize training sessions to encourage our staff to save energy. In our departmental and interdepartmental meetings, we discuss energy savings and make related decisions.

We ensure that the electronic devices we use in our facility are energy-efficient. We carry out periodic and annual maintenance on all our devices to prevent potential energy leaks. We use LED and sensor lighting systems to achieve energy savings. We minimize the duration that cold unit doors are open.

In guest rooms, we use electronic keys. We regulate the opening and closing of thick curtains based on the season and daylight. We use environmental information cards in the rooms to inform guests about turning off unused lights and televisions. We apply a guest placement strategy, starting with guests in the lowest floor rooms.

In the parking lot, common areas, staff restrooms, and staff corridors, we use sensor-activated lighting. We strive to use LED lights instead of fluorescent ones.
